London, 29 January: The President of Colombia, Juan Manuel Santos, and the President of Panama, Juan Carlos Varela, will make the opening and closing keynote speeches at the inaugural <u>IISS</u> Cartagena Dialogue: The Trans-Pacific Summit, taking place from the 6-8 March 2015 in Cartagena, Colombia.

This major new international summit follows in the footsteps of the successful Shangri-La Dialogue, in Singapore, and Manama Dialogue, in Bahrain. It has the full support of the Colombian government and will bring together government ministers, CEOs and influential opinion-formers from the two sides of the Pacific.

The Dialogue will serve as an opportunity for public policy statements and private strategic debate on relations between Latin America (and, in particular, the Pacific Alliance states of Chile, Colombia, Mexico and Peru), the Asia-Pacific and key outside powers.
